625 Private Adam Millikin was born in Kilmarnock, Ayrshire and enlisted into the 16th Lancers in London on 9 July 1830. He served with the regiment in Afghanistan, being present at Ghuznee in 1839 and later the Sutra campaign, taking part in the battles of Aliwal and Sobraon. He died on 1st August 1846, reason unknown. He was not present at Maharajpore, the Ghuznee and Sutra medals being his only entitlement.
