Trooper John Robert Lewis served in the Lydenburg Rifles during the Sekukuni campaign of 1879.

Captain Corrie of the Lydenburg Rifles was the author of the book, The Promised Land, 1884. In it he gives a graphic account of the Second Campaign of the Second Sekukuni War (1879) and of the assault on the Sekukuni's Stad, 28 November 1879, in which the Lydenburg Rifles took a prominent part.

106 medals issued to the Lydenburg Rifles; 102 with clasp '1879'; 47 returned to Woolwich/Mint.
